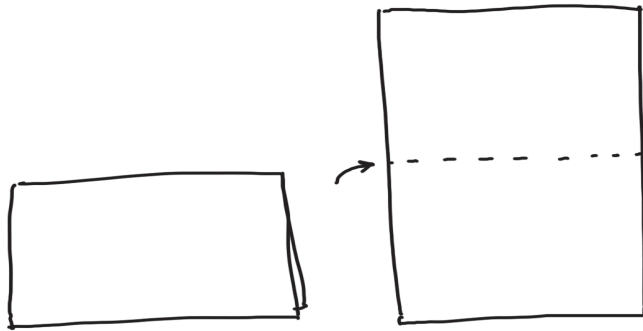
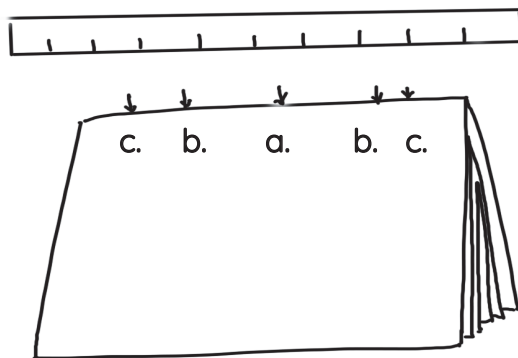


MAKING A SIMPLE SKETCHBOOK



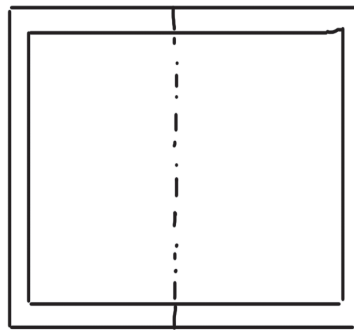
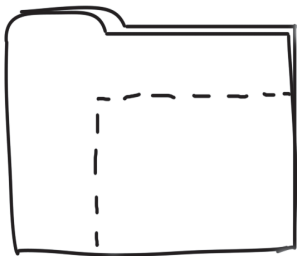
1. Fold a sheet of paper in half.

Repeat for all 10 sheets of paper.



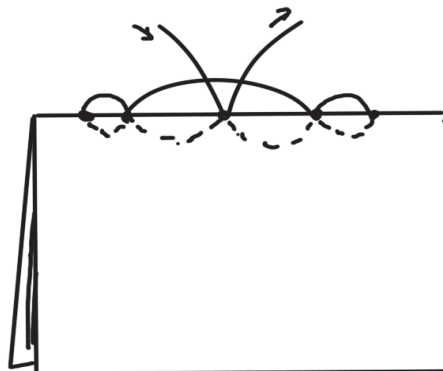
2. With a ruler, make 5 marks:
 - a. The middle.
 - b. Halfway between the middle and each end.
 - c. Halfway between marks "b" and the end.

Use a pin, skewer, or nail to punch holes at the marks. Repeat for each sheet.



3. Cut a folder measuring $\frac{1}{2}$ inch larger than the paper.

Center the stack of paper on the folder. Punch holes through folder to line up with the holes in the paper.



4. Sew your sketchbook together, as shown. Tie the strings with a double knot.

Cover the outside with fabric or paper.
